


Getting started on your e-learning homework. *Doing homework on a computer is MUCH easier than on a touch device.


Step #1





RDP Tables and the eRDPML

Check your understanding of the RDP Table or eRDPML by completing the exam. You will answer 10 multiple choice questions. Please follow these steps:

1. Tap on **Take the Metric Exam** or **Take the Imperial Exam** to start.
2. If you've already signed in, you'll simply be asked to verify your username. If you share this device with another user, you'll be required to re-enter your username.
3. In order to complete the exam, you'll need your RDP Table and/or eRDPML. For your added convenience, you can also use the free online version of the eRDPML. If you decide to use the eRDPML online, you'll need to log in and use the home button on your device – iOS or Android – to toggle between the exam and the eRDPML online.
4. Read each question completely before selecting your answer. If you answer a question incorrectly, carefully read the explanation provided and make a note of the section to visit on the *Open Water Diver Touch* should you need further explanation. Then, continue to the next question.
5. After you've answered all questions correctly, you'll be asked to accept the Student Diver Statement. This statement is your agreement that you either understand the questions you missed, or that, if you still don't fully understand something, you will review the appropriate sections and/or discuss the question(s) with your instructor until you understand. If you did not pass with a score of 75 percent or higher, you'll be directed to a new page; tap **Start Over** to retake the exam.

After successfully completing the exam, you will be taken to the **Submission** page. If you're connected to the Internet, simply sign in and enter your password, then tap the **Submit** button to record your score. If you aren't connected, your exam score will be saved in your profile; later, when you connect to the Internet, simply go to the **Summary** page, where you can submit this exam score as well as scores from the knowledge reviews and quizzes you've also finished.
